



### **Biography – Dr. Don Roth**

Dr. Don Roth is the Associate Director of CAES representing the University of Wyoming and a Professor Emeritus of Molecular Biology. He received his MS and PhD from Virginia Tech and BS from the University of New Hampshire. At UW he was the Deputy Director of UW's School of Energy Resources with cross-college academic responsibilities in the energy arena. He coordinated faculty activities, supervised energy academics at the undergraduate and graduate levels including development of new interdisciplinary programs, directed workforce development and recruiting activities, and established private sector partnerships supporting the SER academic mission. Prior to SER, he was the Dean of Graduate Education administrating graduate programs across the 7 UW colleges. He was also the founding Director of the Biomedical Sciences Program and Director of the K12 Science Posse, a STEM & energy focused education program supported by NSF and NIH. He has published over 120 articles and book chapters, and has 4 patents.
