



Biography – Dr. Noël Bakhtian

Dr. Noël Bakhtian is the Director of the Center for Advanced Energy Studies (CAES), a research consortium between Idaho National Laboratory, Boise State University, Idaho State University, University of Idaho, and University of Wyoming. In this role, she serves as the Associate Director for Idaho National Laboratory at CAES.

Dr. Bakhtian most recently served as a Senior Policy Adviser for environment and energy in the White House Office of Science and Technology Policy (OSTP). Prior to OSTP, she served as the inaugural Energy-Water Nexus lead at the DOE Office of International Affairs, worked as technical lead on numerous innovative grant programs for DOE's Wind and Water Power Technologies Office, consulted on energy R&D and investment for DARPA, and served as an energy and environment Fellow in the U.S. Senate.

Dr. Bakhtian earned her engineering doctorate at Stanford University's Department of Aeronautics and Astronautics; holds masters' degrees from Stanford University and the University of Cambridge, where she was a Churchill Scholar; and completed her bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering and physics at Duke University.
